

Title: Student Council

Approval by: Principal

1 Representation

The Student Council is for grades 5 through 10. No later than three weeks after the beginning of each school year each class shall elect one representative to the council through a written ballot. At their first meeting following the election, the council elects its own leader.

A teacher contact, appointed by the school, may meet at all Student Council meetings. The principal will meet regularly with the student council (usually every other week) to discuss their views and concerns, especially focusing on the school environment and wellbeing of students and any issues concerning bullying or anti-social behaviour.

2 Mandate

The Student Council shall represent the shared interest of all students at IST and strive to create a good learning environment at the school. They also participate in various activities both organised within the school and organised within the local community.

The Council may raise, discuss, or pass resolutions on any subject of relevance to the student body. Any suggestions, recommendations or resolutions from the Council shall be directed to the Principal.

The Student Council has a seat on the school Board, as an observer.
